OFFICIAL SHOW RULES

19th ANNUAL ROBINSON FFA ALUMNI LIVESTOCK SHOW

November 12, 2023 Clifton Youth Fairgrounds

GENERAL RULES – APPLICABLE TO ALL SHOWS

- 1. TEXAS EXHIBITORS ONLY.
- 2. NO HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES.
- 3. Weigh-in Schedule to be posted day of show, subject to changes due to number of entries, weather, etc.
- 4. Show Schedule to be posted day of show, subject to changes due to number of entries, weather, etc.
- 5. No hay is allowed in any barns. Shavings are allowed in the swine barn. You are responsible for removing them at the end of the show.
- 6. Animals must be clipped. **Absolutely no clipping or shearing allowed on grounds.**
- 7. Animals must have horns tipped.
- 8. Animals must be in good health.
- 9. Show Officials reserve the right to disqualify animals that have not been clipped, animals with horns that have not been tipped, or animals suspected to be unhealthy.
- 10. Show Officials reserve the right to reclassify obviously mis-classed entries.

OLD TIMERS SHOW

Specific rules in addition to the General Rules:

- 1. There will be a separate Old Timers Show in the Goat, Swine, and Lamb categories.
- 2. A special prize will be awarded to one winner per category.
- 3. Entry Fee is \$2 cash, per each Entry.

- 4. Exhibitors shall have graduated high school before August 31, 2023.
- 5. Youth Exhibitors are encouraged to enter their parent, guardian, brother, sister, or anyone else. This is to be a fun event.
- 6. Animal weigh-in is NOT required.

SHOWMANSHIP SHOWS

Specific rules in addition to the General Rules:

- 1. There will be separate Senior, Intermediate and Junior Showmanship Shows **for Jackpot Show Exhibitors only** in the Goat, Swine, and Lamb categories.
- 2. A Belt Buckle will be awarded to one Champion per age group per species.
- 3. A special prize will be awarded to one Reserve Champion per age group per species.
- 4. SENIOR Exhibitors shall be currently enrolled in $9^{th} 12^{th}$ grade.
- 5. INTERMEDIATE Exhibitors shall be currently enrolled in $6^{th} 8^{th}$ grade.
- 6. JUNIOR Exhibitors shall be currently enrolled in $3^{rd} 5^{th}$ grade.
- 7. Animal weigh-in is NOT required.

JACKPOT SHOWS

Specific rules in addition to the General Rules:

- 1. There will be separate JACKPOT Shows in the Goat, Swine, and Lamb categories.
- 2. Entry Fee is \$25 cash per each Entry.
- 3. JACKPOT Exhibitors shall be currently enrolled in 3rd-12th grade and shall **NOT** have graduated high school before August 31, 2023.
- 4. JACKPOT Exhibitors shall be a current member of FFA or 4-H Club.
- 5. All Exhibitors must check-in, sign-in, and register at the Show Office.
- 6. Official animal weigh-in is required on site, via scales on site by show officials. Two sets of scales may be used for weigh-ins. Weighing and/or reweighing on both sets of scales is NOT PERMITTED.
- 7. Lamb and Swine Exhibits will be shown by Breed and Weight. Classes will be broken, based on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Show Officials.
- 8. Goat Exhibits will be shown by Weight. Classes will be broken, based on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Show Officials.
- 9. Payback and Awards will be:

- a. **Class Finishers**: Payback, payable to top finishers of each Class, will be 50% of Entry Fees collected for each respective class, divided among the top finishers with amounts determined by pre-set payout chart based on the total number of exhibitors in each Class.
- b. **Breed / Weight Division Reserve and Grand Champions**: Rosettes will be awarded.
- c. **Overall Reserve Champions**: Special Prize will be awarded.
- d. **Overall Grand Champions**: Belt Buckle will be awarded.
